Applications are invited for the post of Junior Research Fellow (JRF) for A DRDO Grants-in-Aid research project titled "Development of Multifunctional Perovskite Materials for Device Applications".

Educational Qualification

Applicants must possess first class M. Sc. degree in Physics with preferable specialization in Materials science/ Solid State Physics. NET/GATE qualified candidates will be preferred.

Candidates with M. Tech degree in Nanoscience and Technology/ Ceramics/ Material Science are also eligible to apply.

Stipend and Tenure of JRF

The stipend of JRF for first two years will be Rs. 25000/-pm + HRA @20% and SRF for the third year Rs. 28000/-pm + HRA @ 20%.

Age:

For Junior Research Fellows (JRF) maximum 28 years, as on the last date for receipt of application (Relaxable for 5 years for SC/ST and 3 years for OBC as per govt. rules).
