5. Experience certificate from present employer /institute for post where certificate is must.

6. Candidates will enclose a self addressed envelope affixing postal stamps of Rs 25/- required for registered cover for return of acknowledgement card so as to reach **Commandant CVD, Delhi Cantt PIN 900106 C/o 56 APO by 1600 hrs within twenty one days from the date of publication of this advt.** The covering letter/envelop should be marked with **“Application for the post of .....**”. No application will be entertained after closing date i.e 21<sup>st</sup> day from the date of publication of this advertisement notice.

7. Acknowledgement card will only be sent to candidate who have fulfilled all above criteria. Application will be rejected for incomplete documents as per advertised.

8.. Test/Interview will be held at CVD Delhi Cantt on dates mentioned in Acknowledgement Card for each. Applicants should report at CVD Delhi Cantt on the date and time of test/interview as mentioned in the Acknowledge Card. No separate letter except Acknowledgement Card will be issued. No candidate will be allowed to attend the test if reports to venue after time specified.

9. The individual should be in possession of **acknowledgement card** on first day. All **original documents will be brought by only those candidates who qualify for interview.** No individual will be entertained who is not in possession of Acknowledgement Card issued by the depot. No mobiles or other personal belonging should be brought on day one of reporting for test.

10. The number of candidates may be reduced to a minimum of 50 times of the vacancies for one category of post by screening of applications on the basis of percentage of marks obtained in the examination for essential qualification will be carried out. A bench mark percentage will be fixed depending on the number of applications. No weightage will be given for additional/higher qualification (other than those prescribed in the Recruitment Rules). All candidates meeting the bench-mark will be allowed to appear in the written examination. The administration reserves the right to fix a cut off/bench mark percentage on receipt of applications for which no one will have right to question/represent.



11. The number of candidates to be called for interview after undergoing written exam and physical test may be restricted to 10 times of number of vacancies. The candidates who fail to qualify in the physical test/typing test (wherever applicable) shall not be permitted to undergo written test. Short listing of candidates for interview shall be carried out based on the performance in written exam and physical test/skill test (wherever applicable). This will be decided on merit basis by competent authority.

12. It is made clear that 'merely fulfilling the basic essential qualification requirements (QR) does not automatically entitle a candidate to be called for test/interview'. It is also made clear that 'number of posts may undergo change at any stage' if considered essential.

13 Physical test/timed run (wherever applicable) may be incorporated at initial stage due to administrative constraints for any post prior to written test. The selection will be made strictly on the merit basis. The selection process will comprise of written test and physical/practical tests. The decision of Appointing Authority regarding selection/rejection will be final.

14. Provided that candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribe, OBC, PH and ESM may be called for the skill/practical Test by the Board of Officers by applying relaxed standards if the Board of Officers is of the opinion that sufficient number of candidates of these categories are not likely to be called for the skill test on the basis of general standard in order to fill up the vacancies reserved for these categories (ie SC, ST, OBC, ESM and PH).

15. The candidates belongs to SC/ST/OBC/PH cat have a right to compete with gen candidates against UR vacancies. In such cases no concession or relaxation will be provided to the SC/ST/OBC/PH candidates.

16 Central Government civilian employees must attach "No Objection Certificate" duly authenticated by their Employer/Office alongwith application and also keep the same at the time of the skill/practical test. In the event of their final selection for the relevant posts, they would be relieved by their office for joining the new post/service else their candidature will be cancelled.

**NOTE**

- (a) Grading will be done on based of marks obtained in written test.
- (ii) Negative marking 0.25 marks for each wrong answer.
- (iii) Only those candidates who secure at least the minimum qualifying marks in the physical/skill test (wherever applicable) as may be fixed by competent authority, will be called for written test.
- (iv) Marks obtained out of 150 will be calculated as per weightage of written test for respective post  $\{(Total\ marks\ obtained) \times (80\ or\ 40)\} / 150$ , as separate marks should be allotted in written, practical/physical test and interview in the ratio of 40:40:20. In that case, where physical/practical test not applicable, written test and interview marks should be allotted in the ratio of 80:20.

18. **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS**

(a) Please note that incomplete applications without affixing attested photograph, mismatching photograph or without enclosing attested copies of educational certificate, date of birth, and or caste certificate and or experience certificate (as applicable) and or if applicant is found overage/underage on last date of receipt of application as indicated above will be rejected without intimation to the candidate.
